# MINUTES EMPORIA REDEVELOPMENT & HOUSING AUTHORITY CITY OF EMPORIA MUNICIPAL BUILDING REGULAR MEETING January 21, 2015

The Emporia Redevelopment and Housing Authority held a Regular Meeting on Wednesday, January 21, 2015 at 5:30 p.m. in the Council Chamber of the Municipal Building, 201 South Main Street, Emporia, Virginia. Veronica Leach, Chairperson presided over the meeting.

#### APPROVAL OF FINANCIAL REPORT

Ms. Cutrell stated that the financial report detailing revenues and expenditures that occurred during the period of September 27, 2014 – December 31, 2014 had been distributed to the Commissioners. She reported that the certificate of deposit that matured in November 2014 was renewed with Carter Bank and Trust for a term of 12 months at an interest rate of .70%

There was no discussion regarding the financial report.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

#### 15-01 - ERHA Bylaws - Request to Amend

Mr. Thrower stated that the Election or Appointment section of the bylaws states that "the City Council of the City of Emporia shall appoint all Commissioners of the Board of Directors to a term of four years not to exceed two consecutive terms. The Board of Directors shall elect annually at the first meeting in January a Chairperson and Vice-Chairperson from within the ranks of the appointed Commissioners of the Board who shall serve for no more than two consecutive years. The Board of Directors shall appoint the Executive Director, Fiscal Agent, and Clerk from existing City of Emporia personnel, all of whom shall serve without any compensation and at the pleasure of the Authority's Board of Directors".

Mr. Thrower stated that he was not aware of any State prohibition on term limitations and recommended removing "not to exceed two consecutive terms."

Commissioner Thomas made a motion to adopt **Resolution No. 14-02** to amend the bylaws as presented, seconded by Commissioner Lankford which passed as follows:

#### 15-02 - Appointment of Chairperson and Vice Chairperson

Mr. Thrower advised that, as per the bylaws, the Board of Directors shall elect annually at the first meeting in January a Chairperson and Vice-Chairperson from within the ranks of the appointed Commissioners of the Board who shall serve for no more than two consecutive years.

#### 15-03 - Purchase of Property in Support of Neighborhood Revitalization - Update

Mr. Thrower stated that the City has been working on the West Atlantic Street Neighborhood Revitalization project for several years. He also stated that the project has included housing rehabilitation, derelict structure demolition, and capital improvements.

He stated that Dr. Edwin C. Daley was present to discuss the project.

Dr. Daley advised that part of this effort included the purchase and clearing of several lots with the goal of creating home ownership opportunities for low and moderate income citizens. He also advised that a total of nine lots were included in this effort. He further advised that five of the lots on Washington Street were reconfigured into three lots. He stated that two of these new lots have been transferred to Habitat for Humanity. He also stated that it is intended that the five (formerly six) remaining lots be used to create new housing construction opportunities.

He stated that he would like to ask the Emporia Housing and Redevelopment Authority to purchase the remaining grant properties to be used for new housing construction. He also stated that the proposed purchase price after discussions with DHCD staff is \$14,272.22 based on grant expenditures for the properties.

He advised that City staff will be available to assist the Authority with the marketing and transfer of the properties for the development of low and moderate, owner-occupied housing.

Commissioner Carey asked which account would the funds be taken from. Ms. Cutrell advised that the funds would come from the certificate of deposit. She also advised that the penalty for removing funds from the certificate of deposit would be three months' worth of interest which would total \$66.40. She further advised that the current interest rate is .70%. She stated that if a portion of the funds were removed from the certificate of deposit and the remaining funds were reinvested, the interest rate would increase to .80%. She also stated that a portion of the funds could be removed from the checking account which has a balance of \$5,019.44 with the majority of the

funds being removed from the certificate of deposit.

Commissioner Lankford made a motion for the Executive Director to negotiate and execute a contract to purchase the remaining grant properties with ERHA funding, subject to approval by Department of Housing and Community Development, seconded by Commissioner Thomas which passed as follows:

Home Repair Program – Review of Approved Applications

ITEM:

As of Friday, March 27, 2015 the City received a total of 13 applications. Internal review of the applications determined nine were not eligible. Letters were mailed to the applicants detailing the reasoning for denial. The nine applications were denied for the following reasons: two incomplete, three excessively exceed income limits, two had previously received funding, and two had delinquent taxes.

Of those preliminarily approved, two are in the Lowground area and two are City-wide. The attached document details the requested improvements.

A Request for Bids will be prepared to solicit one contractor to perform all work approved in this round of the Home Repair Program. The procurement will be handled in accordance with the City of Emporia's Small Purchase Policy. The contract will be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder.

#### Recommendation

I recommend you determine the improvements to be completed for all four approved Home Repair Program applications. I also recommend you authorize staff to issue the Request for Bids document based on these improvements. I will then bring back the bid results for your consideration.

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#### Ordinance

An Ordinance To Adopt The 2015-2016 Operating Budget For The Emporia Redevelopment and Housing Authority Of The City Of Emporia And To Appropriate The Funds For The Same

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Emporia Redevelopment And Housing Authority of the City of Emporia, Virginia as follows:

- 1. That the Emporia Redevelopment And Housing Authority herby approves and adopts the document entitled "Emporia Redevelopment and Housing Authority Operating Budget For Fiscal Year 2015-2016."
- 2. In order to provide the requisite funds for said operating budget, the sum of \$90,067 is hereby appropriated to the Emporia Redevelopment and Housing Authority expenditure account for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2015 and ending June 30, 2016.
- The Executive Director is hereby authorized and directed to do all things necessary to
  implement said budget to include executing all purchase orders of any amounts and
  making all payments and disbursements consistent with the purpose and intent of this
  budget.
- 4. This ordinance shall be in effect on and after its adoption
