

Home Repair Grant Program

Emporia Redevelopment and Housing Authority

The ERHA is soliciting applications from homeowners to participate in its Home Repair Grant Program. The ERHA is offering grants to qualified homeowners to be used for repairs and/or improvements to the interior and/or exterior of their house/property. Priority is given to repairs addressing health/safety needs and to applicants who have not received funding in the past.

Applicants may not exceed 80% of median household income as determined by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for Emporia. Applicants must also reside in the City and be current on all taxes, fees, and bills owed to the City.

The maximum grant award is \$5,000 for the “Lowground Road Area” of the City. Streets include Zion Boulevard, Harrje Street, Wadlow Street, Astrio Street, Clay Street, Faison Street, and Turner Street. The maximum grant award for all other areas of the City is \$500. All applications are subject to ERHA approval and funding constraints.
