Separate sealed bids for the construction of the West Atlantic Street Neighborhood Revitalization Infrastructure Improvements - Phase II will be received at the City Manager's Office, 201 South Main Street, Emporia, Virginia 23847, until 2:00 PM, local prevailing time on Thursday, July 31, 2014, and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud.

The project consists of street and drainage improvements in the West Atlantic Street Neighborhood in the City of Emporia, Virginia. Work under this Contract is generally described as follows: Furnishing materials and labor for the installation of curb, gutter, sidewalk, and pavement overlay along Maryland Avenue, Washington Street, and Pennsylvania Street, the replacement/adjustment of associated drainage structures, the milling and/or overlay of Florida Avenue, Delaware Street, and a section of Pine Street, and all associated clearing and grubbing, and erosion and sediment control. Alternate bid items include relocation of existing water meters and cleanouts, and the replacement of approximately 300 LF of 6-inch gravity sanitary sewer.
