Separate sealed bids for the construction of the West Atlantic Street Sanitary Sewer Replacement will be received at the City Manager's Office, 201 South Main Street, Emporia, Virginia 23847, until **2:30 PM**, local prevailing time on **Wednesday, September 3, 2014**, and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud.

The project consists of the removal and replacement of existing gravity sanitary sewer on West Atlantic Street in the City of Emporia, Virginia. Work includes the replacement of approximately 490 LF of 10-inch gravity sanitary sewer and 1,230 LF of 8-inch gravity sanitary sewer, as well as the removal and replacement of associated manholes and reconnection of existing sanitary sewer laterals to the new gravity sewer, and pavement restoration.
